## **When is the library open?**

7:30- 2:15 Every day school is in session

Please note that when there are School Improvement Days (SIPdays) or early dismissal days, we will close when the buses leave.

Come down as a class, get a pass from a teacher, get a lunch pass from the lunchroom aides or during homeroom .



## Library Checkout

Maximum of 5 items may be checked out at one time. 10 school days (2 week) check-out for books, videos, audiobooks, and back issues of magazines.

A one day grace period on returns will apply and after that 5 cents per school day on overdue books and magazines. 50 cents will be charged for overdue videos, audiobooks on CD, Playaways, MP3 players per school day.

If you owe \$1 or more on an overdue item, no check-outs will be allowed until it is returned and the amount is paid.

If any item is overdue longer than a month, the student will be responsible for the purchase price or the return of the book and overdue fines.

A student ID is required in order to check out material.

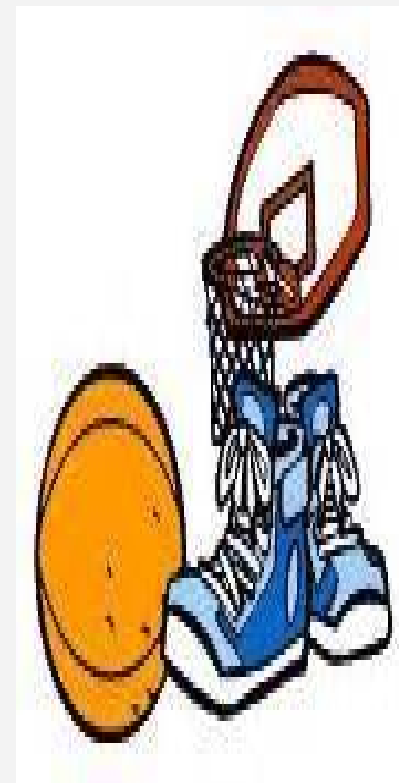
## How do I know when my book is due?
