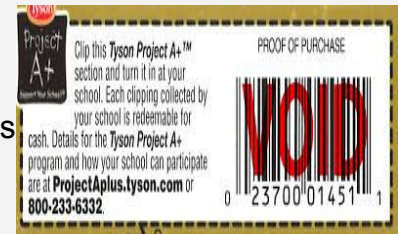

New Grant Awarded

The library successfully completed and was awarded the FY2017 School Library District grant which earned approximately \$0.65 per student. These funds will be spent on electronic resources and high quality books for our students.

Electronic Check-In

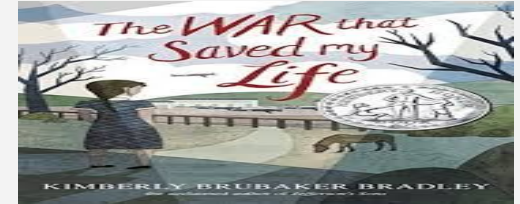
Rebecca Caudill Young Reader's Book Award

Our Online Book Fair will run until **March 7**. Books purchased this way will be delivered to BPMS Library, who will hand-deliver the books to the students in their homeroom.

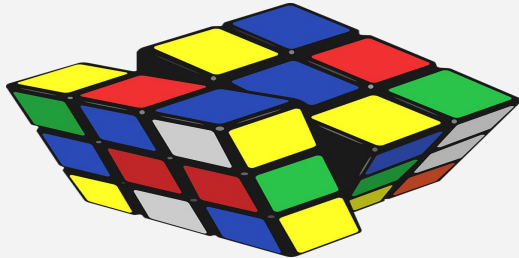
Book It! (Read for Pizza)

Checkout is for 3 school days
Late fees are 50 cents per day

Rubik's cubes range from \$10 - \$40 to replace.
Students must sign that they have read the rules before they can check out.

Library Checkout

Maximum of 5 items may be checked out at one time.

10 school days (2 week) check-out for books, videos, audiobooks, and back issues of magazines.

A one day grace period on returns will apply and after that 5 cents per school day on overdue books and magazines. 50 cents will be charged for overdue videos, audiobooks on CD, Playaways, MP3 players per school day.

If you owe \$1 or more on an overdue item, no check-outs will be allowed until it is returned and the amount is paid.

If any item is overdue longer than a month, the student will be responsible for the purchase price or the return of the book and overdue fines.

A student ID is required in order to check out material.
